



<u>Cleaning – wash, clean, and wipe the following:</u>
<input type="checkbox"/> doors, windows, siding, and trims
<input type="checkbox"/> sweep front porch and all other pathways around the home
<input type="checkbox"/> sweep driveway and walkway
<input type="checkbox"/> outdoor lighting
<input type="checkbox"/> drains and gutters
<input type="checkbox"/> railings and glass panels
<input type="checkbox"/> garage door - outside and inside
<input type="checkbox"/> clean house foundation with a broom. Use wood chips in beds by house to prevent future dirt splatters
<input type="checkbox"/> outdoor furniture including patio chairs and tables
<input type="checkbox"/> power wash deck. For composite boards, scrub and rinse
<input type="checkbox"/> garage floor, making sure to get rid of all salt and dirt
<input type="checkbox"/> <u>Maintenance, renovation and repairs – check, fix, and replace as needed</u>
<input type="checkbox"/> caulking around entry points including doors and windows. Replace cracked caulking with fresh caulking
<input type="checkbox"/> outdoor lightbulbs
<input type="checkbox"/> cracks and loose boards that need replacement
<input type="checkbox"/> gutters
<input type="checkbox"/> fences and gates
<input type="checkbox"/> cracks in driveway – seal as needed
<input type="checkbox"/> foundation crack - seal with cement and paint
<input type="checkbox"/> patio and window screens – look for small holes and tears

<input type="checkbox"/> research landscaping companies if planning to outsource landscaping
<input type="checkbox"/> if planning to re-do landscape, research landscaping ideas to choose your own landscape design
